

In this view, the Main I & M Canal runs left to right across the center. The Fox River Feeder enters at the upper right and goes diagonally southwest before curving south to the main canal. Opposite where the feeder reaches the main canal, the Lateral Canal goes south down the east side of Canal Street to the Hydraulic Basin at Race Street. The lock interrupted W. Superior St.
