- ORIGINALLY A ONE STOREY STONE STRUCTURE .
- A FRAME SECOND STORY, KITCHEN WING AND GARAGE ARE ALL LATER ADDITIONS
- LOOPHOLES FOR DEFENSIVE PURPOSES HAVE ALL BEEN BLOCKED IN
- ORIGINAL ENCLOSED STONE PORCH STILL EXISTS, HOWEVER A SECOND STOREY PORCH HAS BEEN ADDED .
