DESCRIPTION: (Type of navigation, features of canal (include USGS coordinates where useful); e.g., feeders (navigable & otherwise), locks other than above, type of locks, use of unusual material or methods of construction, present owner, present use & condition, etc.)

Commercial transportation & passenger service. Towpath on all points of dug canal. Slackwater between dams, towing then on either side. Moshassuck and Blackstone Rivers canalized in sections. All locks except tidewater lock (which was wood) were of granite. There were several feeders, not navigable. A 5 span aqueduct was at Uxbridge, wood trough. Property owners today, check with DNR in some areas. Possible P. & W. Railroad also. Sections of canal in very good condition north of Providence, some dry, some well watered. Certain sections considered for parks. See reports of DNR (Mass.) as of 1971-74. The Millbury area had some locks 90-126 ft. Whether this was a change in structure later or during construction is not known. No one has been able to account for the total of 62 locks to date. Locally, we would like to know where the other 13 locks were built. More research may clear that situation.

 To open a means of inland waterway transportation from the seaport town of Providence, R.I. - Worcester, Mass. (48 miles) An elevation of 451 ft. above tidewater; Dates of incorporation for Massachusetts March 1823; For Rhode Island ~~June~~ June 1823; Height of traffic about 1844; Prominent engineers - Benj. Wright: In Mass. Joseph D. Allan; In Rhode Island Holmes Hutchinson; Presumably others as well. Transfers of ownership reverted back to former land owners in some cases, after canal was abandoned in 1848. Much of the "Canal Company Property" was also sold to the P. & W. Railroad about 1846. Sections of the towpaths were used as the railroad bed (still close to the canal). Closure caused by coming of the railroads. Boston to Worcester & the Providence & Worcester R.R. in 1847.
